

Our School Values.

At Woodham Burn Community Primary School and Nursery, we have 6 values which are at the heart of everything we do.

The School council worked hard to help develop 6 school values.

After sharing a number of values with the school during an assembly, they then asked all children to vote on which they felt were the 6 most important values.

Voting took place and our Values appeared.

This gave us 6 values that the children of Woodham Burn Community Primary School and Nursery feel are important for all adults and children to follow to allow us all to work and learn in a positive, warm and welcoming environment.

Learning

Team work / co-operation

Respect

Independence

Equality



Each week, we focus on a different value. Other values will be spoken about, and children will be praised when showing values, however each value has a weekly focus.

Each value focus will be launched on a Monday morning during assembly. Children and staff will be told what the value of the week is, and staff will then look to see which pupils are demonstrating the value during the week, so that they can pick a star of the week, based on the weeks value.

On a Wednesday, a further assembly will look in more detail at the value of the week. This is to develop a shared understanding within school, of what each value means and how we can demonstrate we and others in school are leading by example. Discussions and stories are used to help develop understanding.

On a Friday, we have celebration assembly. Staff and children come together at the end of the week to share who is the star of the week for each class, based on the value shared on Monday morning. The star pupils are also celebrated on twitter and the weekly newsletter.

Over the coming year, we will be linking our values into our curriculum, so that they continue to grow. Further information will follow.
